## Connect to PrinterNet via...

### Existing wireless Wi-Fi Network

Wi-Fi

#### Advantages

- Installation is quick and easy
- Access available anywhere within the Wi-Fi network range
- Speeds of up to 300Mbps
- No hidden costs
- Can have multiple connections



#### Factors to consider

- Need access to an existing Wi-Fi network with a firewall
- Dedicated, password protected connection required
- Wi-Fi extenders may be required for hard to reach areas

### Existing wired network



#### Advantages

- Much greater speed than Wi-Fi
- Easy to connect with one cable
- Security managed by your IT department
- Low cost to connect to existing network
- Unlikely to be subject to disruption

#### Factors to consider

- Requires cabling to each printer
- May require IT department involvement to add printers to the existing network

### Wi-Fi Hotspot



A mobile router will give the same benefits as an existing Wi-Fi network. The mobile router uses a SIM card which gives connection to the mobile network, similar to a mobile phone



#### Advantages

- Creates its own Wi-Fi network
- Generally, needs no IT involvement as works totally independently of any existing network
- Can be a relatively cheap option for remote areas or where Wi-Fi is not available

#### Factors to consider

- Cost of data dependent on local service provider contract
- Cost of router
- Connected devices limit on most routers of 32
- High number of connected devices may impact performance
